

The announcement of Visa Exemption to enter Myanmar for ordinary passport holders of Japan and South Korea

The tourist from Japan and South Korea, who hold the ordinary passport, are granted visa-free entry to the Republic of the Union of Myanmar will effect from 1st October 2018 from 30th September 2019 as the trial (1) year period. In this regards, the required terms and conditions for the tourist are as follows –

- (a) They are eligible to enter from International Airport of Yangon, Mandalay, and Nay Pyi Taw, International Port of Yangon, Myanmar-Thailand Land Border Checkpoint in Tachileik, Mayawaddy, Kawthaung, and Hteekee.
- (b) Visa Exemption is granted for tourism purpose only and Tourist Visa will be issued.
- (c) Duration of the stay is 30 days and stays cannot be extended.
- (d) Package Tour and the FIT (Free Independent Traveler) are eligible to apply for visa exemption. The letter or recommendation from the related department, institution or company is not necessary to submit for application, however, the applicant has to grant for tourism purpose only.
- (e) They have to strictly abide by the existing laws, rules, procedures, orders and directives issued by Myanmar Government.
- (f) They can travel freely in Myanmar except Restricted Areas.
- (g) US Dollar 1,000 have to show as Show Money at the entry.
- (h) The Immigration and respective authority concerned have right to deny the entry if the applicant is not eligible to enter after verified.
- (i) The Return Air Ticket (or) Air Ticket to the third country, the validity of within one month, has to submit.
- (j) They can depart from Myanmar from all international entry/exit point.
