Required documents for travelers (Non Myanmar Citizens) who wish to enter Myanmar through commercial flights

1. As the COVID-19 infection rate has been significantly decreasing in the country, the Government of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar has allowed to resume international commercial flights for travelers since 17 April 2022 in line with the entry rules and regulations prescribed by the Central Committee on Prevention, Control and Treatment of COVID-19.
2. In this regard, the Embassy hereby informs that travelers (Non Myanmar Citizens) wishing to enter Myanmar must submit the following documents:
 - a. A COVID-19 vaccination certificate

 - b. A negative COVID-19 RT-PCR test issued 72 hours ahead of arrival to Myanmar
 - c. A COVID-19 medical insurance purchased from Myanma Insurance
