(A) For local Students

1. The applicants who are Buddhist monks must have passed Dhammacariya Degree.
2. The applicants who are nuns, lay persons (male/female) must have their first degree from any University.
3. The applicants must be proficiency in English (writing, reading and speaking).

(B) For Foreign Students

1. The foreign applicants (monks, nuns, male, female) must have passed at least the matriculation examination or equivalent level.
2. The applicants must be proficiency in English (writing, reading and speaking). (Both local and foreign applicants must forward their original degree certificates when they submit their application forms.)
3. The applicants must not be younger than the age of 18 and older than 45
4. The applicants must be free from the diseases such as leprosy, skin disease, transmitted disease and psychic abnormality.
